Clinical Review	All parts of the process for making a determination of the need for a Level II evaluation for all cases where the algorithm was inconclusive. The review is inclusive of requests for additional information from the referral source or other individuals	
Community Placement	Any housing situation aside from state center, hospital or nursing facility—this includes, but is not limited to, Assisted Living Facilities, Hospice, group homes, independent living homes, and senior communities	
Dual Diagnosis	Mental Illness and Intellectual Disability and/or a Related Condition	
Group/Individual In- Reach	Options counseling provided in an individual or group setting in the NF that assists Members interested in transitioning from LTC to a community setting	
Health First Colorado	Colorado Medicaid Program	
Legal Guardian	The person or entity who is court appointed and legally responsible for decision-making on behalf of an individual.	
Level I	PASRR screening tool for persons admitting to Medicaid certified NFs, to identify those who have or may have a known or suspected Serious Mental Illness (SMI), intellectual/Developmental Disability (ID/DD), or Related Condition (RC)	
Level I PASRR	All parts of the process from the receipt of the Level I Screen from the referral

PASRR Related Condition	Mental illness, or an Intellectual or Development Disability or related condition that may require specialized services.
Provider	Health care provider or agency providing medical care or services

QC	Maximus staff: Quality Coordinator responsible for reviewing the clinical elements of the assessment, making determinations, writing summary reports, and completing the workflow process
